Juniors: 17 years of age and under.

Masters: 50 years of age and over

Preparatory Tests: Class 1 Open to horses which have not won two 1sts in Preparatory tests or higher .

Class 2 Open to any horse regardless of previous placings or grading.

In the case of cancellation of the event, an administration fee of 20% of entries may be retained by the organizers. 9. Supervision of horses is the sole responsibility of the owner/rider and any horse or competitor behaving in a disruptive or dangerous manner may be eliminated and asked to leave the venue. 10. Please provide a stamped self addressed business sized envelope on the day for posted results. 11. Ribbons to 6th place in all classes.
